No.1	NO	Limitation on increasing residential real estate assessments for improvements to flood	#201
No.2	NO	Abolishing the Constitution Revision Commission. It meets every 20 years and is one method to submit proposed amendments or revisions to electors (which can be done by citizen initiatives, constitutional convention, Taxation & Budget Reform Commission or through the Florida legislature).	#203
No.3	NO	Grant additional exemption up to \$50,000 on homestead property owned by classroom teachers, law enforcement officers, correctional officers, firefighters, EMTs, paramedics, child welfare services professionals, active duty military, and Florida National Guard. To take effect January 1, 2023.	#205

No.1	YES	Amend County Charter to require that County Commissioners and Mayor swear/affirm that they will support, protect and defend Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter and the government of Miami-Dade County.	#206
No.2	YES	Amend Charter so that acts of Board of County Commissioners to transfer ownership of Miami Int'l Airport, PortMiami, or Miami-Dade Expressway Authority be approved by majority vote at next General Election.	#208

VOTE YES Approve Ad Valorem Levy for improving compensation of Teachers, Instructional Personnel, Student Safety and Security			#210
<b>2022 CITY OF MIAMI REFERENDUM</b>			
VOTE YES Lease extension to redevelop existing Hyatt Hotel and Knight Center at 400 SE 2nd Ave to include public river-front green space, new Hyatt hotel, parking, convention space, and apartments, increase rent from \$250,000 to \$2,500,000 or 2.5% of gross revenue, whichever is greater. At least \$25,000,000 affordable housing contribution, expanded riverwalk.			#228
